2021 Open Burning Permit Application

You can skip the lines for burn permits this year, mail your check and this form completely filled out to AFD, 1476 West St, Attleboro MA 02703. You will receive your open burn permit in the mail or by email, just check the appropriate box below. Please note permits are not valid until January 15, 2021.

Burning season is January 15th – May 1st 4:00pm

Restrictions/Conditions: Only brush, cane, driftwood, and forestry debris shall be burned. Treated or painted wood shall not be burned. Fire shall burn between 10:00am and 4:00pm. No fires shall be started after 12 noon. Permitted open fires shall not be located less than 75 feet from a structure. Conditions that could cause a fire to spread within 25 feet of a structure shall be eliminated. There shall be a responsible person in attendance at all times. The burning of brush, trees, cane, and driftwood from commercial or institutional land clearing operations is prohibited. The burning of grass, hay, leaves, stumps and tires are prohibited. The stacking, placing, or storing combustible material such that the department may presume it will be burned is prohibited. A garden hose connected to a water supply or suitable fire extinguishing equipment shall be readily available. Permit must be readily available upon request. Find out if you can burn by calling **617-556-1021** between 9:00 am and noon, listen for the OK to burn message.
