SMOKE & CARBON MONOXIDE REQUIREMENTS

Per 527 CMR 31.00 & 32.00 and MGL c. 148 26F & 26 1/2

The following rules and conditions are to be met prior to the arrival of the fire department inspector: (Don't wait until the last minute!)

- 1. Make sure that your posted street number is visible from the street per (MGL c. 148 S 59);
- 2. Make sure that you have the proper "type" of detectors.
 - The inspector may require that they be taken down for compliance verification.
 - Make sure that all detectors are installed in the proper locations. (Also see the manufacturer's instructions)
 - Make sure that all detectors are working properly fresh batteries, plugged in if a/c power, audible alarm works.
 - It is the owner's or his/her authorized designee's responsibility to test, install or repair the smoke or carbon monoxide detectors not the fire department inspector.
- 3. A guide is available on-line at www.mass.gov/dfs and must be read completely and followed in order to understand the requirements. Questions on special situations should be directed to the Fire Prevention Captain only after consulting with the realtor or online at the Fire Services website www.mass.gov/dfs.

The inspector will make every attempt to arrive between the allotted hours of 9:00 AM - 12:00 Noon; however, due unforeseen circumstances, the inspector could arrive early or late.

Massachusetts building codes and fire prevention regulations require that all homes are appropriately equipped with approved smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors at all times. The home is required to be in compliance with these codes and regulations prior to your scheduled appointment. In the event that no one is home and a lock box was not available, it will result in a failure.

I understand the above rules and requests and have followed them. I also understand if I fail the inspection, I will have to re-apply, pay the fee again, and make another appointment when available, even if the inspection occurred earlier or later than the original assigned time-slot.

I understand and acknowledge that the Fire Department can cancel and reschedule this inspection without any prior notice.
